



Early Law School Admission Program *Instructions to Recommenders*

Background

The Early Law School Admission Program (ELSAP) in the School of Education and Social Sciences provides high-performing students who desire to go to law school the opportunity to complete three years of undergraduate work at RMU followed by three years of law school at Duquesne University School of Law. The credits from the first year of law school are counted towards the Bachelor's. Students graduate with their undergraduate class four years after they matriculate at RMU.

The program works with the following majors in the School of Education and Social Sciences:

- B.A. in History
- B.A. in Sociology
- B.A. in Social Science
- B.A. in Political Science
- B.S. in Psychology

Application Eligibility

Full-time on-ground freshmen students who have received a 3.5 or higher in their first semester at RMU and who have a recorded standardized test score of either at least 21 on the ACT or a 1040 on the SAT will be eligible for the program.

Letter of Recommendation

Part of the application process is the student submitting a letter of recommendation from an RMU professor they have had in class.
